All you need to get started is an internet connection and a library card

Where is the magazine catalog?

Go to krl.org.

Hover your mouse over **Download** and click on **Magazines**.

Android or Apple Device

1. **Register** for an RBdigital account via our KRL digital magazine catalog (see 'Tips' below.)
2. **Install** the app **RBdigital** from the App Store or Google Play.
3. **Open** the app and follow prompts to **create a profile** using your RBdigital account.
4. **Tap** the menu  then **tap Home** to browse the catalog.
5. **Tap** title to enjoy.


Computer

1. **Register** for an RBdigital account via our KRL digital magazine catalog (see 'Tips' below.)
2. **Tap** title to enjoy.

Tips for account registration

- Your RBdigital account is **completely separate** from your library account.
- When you register for an RBdigital account, you will be prompted to **create a username**.
- You will be prompted to **create a password**. The password must be 4 characters and may include both letters & numbers.

About downloading magazines

- **No loan period:** the magazine is yours until you delete it
- **No hold list:** available immediately
- **No limit:** download as many issues as you want
- **Current issues** available now
- Digital magazines **look exactly like paper** magazines
- Read them on your **computer, phone, and/or tablet**
- Yes, you can **print individual pages** (from a computer, not the app)
- You can download digital magazines from other libraries. First, go to their website and navigate to their digital magazines catalog. Then, **register** your RBdigital account using the same username and password created when you registered via KRL. Lastly, **open** your app, **tap** the menu and **tap Your Profiles**. Click  (upper right) and follow prompts.
- All checked out magazines, regardless of library of origin, are available via any of your profiles.
